Introduction

Students will watch an educational video on complete and incomplete metamorphosis, then answer a writing prompt.

Learning Objectives

- Students will compare and contrast complete metamorphosis and incomplete metamorphosis.

Materials Needed

Procedure

1. Show students the educational video on complete and incomplete metamorphosis
2. Then go through the video once again, but this time pausing the video each time you want to elaborate on something you saw in the video. Make sure you write down important key words on the front board so students will remember them and can use them to answer the writing prompt.
3. Next, instruct students to write a short essay (a few sentences) about what they saw and include supporting details. Students must answer the writing prompt: "What is the difference between complete and incomplete metamorphosis?" Younger students can draw pictures. Encourage students to use the key words that are written on the front board.

Evaluation

Students will be assessed on how well they followed the guidelines for the writing prompt.
